Presidency in numbers

- 184 days of the Polish Presidency
- 1200 experts trained
- Over 30 000 delegates – participants of the meetings in Poland
- 80 liaison officers recruited from over 2800 candidates
- 430 mln PLN – total budget for the years 2010-12
- Over 10 mln PLN savings thanks to the assistance of partners

Presidency in numbers

- Cities where the main events of the Presidency will take place, in accordance with the model „region by region”, are as follows: Sopot, Wrocław, Kraków, Poznań and Warszawa

- Over 300 expert meetings and almost 200 events with the support of the Presidency
- Around 1500 meetings in Brussels and Luxembourg
